ohnny Depp appeared in a London court on Wednesday to hear his lawyer argue that Depp's ex-wife had lied when she accused him of beating her in comments quoted by a tabloid newspaper in the UK. Depp is suing the tabloid's publisher, and its executive editor Dan Wootton for libel over an article that called Depp a "wife beater". The trial proper is due to start on March 23. Both Depp and his ex-wife Amber Heard accused each other of physical abuse during their relationship. Heard first made allegations in 2016, which Depp denied. "One of them is lying and doing so on a grand scale," said a skeleton argument submitted by Depp's lawyers. "It is a very important function therefore of this libel trial that these allegations are tested, and either


proved or disproved." The onus in the case is on the publication to prove that it has not committed libel. It will argue simply that the article is not defamatory because it is true.

by it anymore. It has become my friend," she says, adding, "The aware-



do is not restricted by theme,


material or the medium that

# 'I was in Class 4 when I faced the camera for the first time'

y first experience in front of the camera was quite an amusing one. My appa (K Bhagyaraj) was making Vaettiya Madichu Kattu then and he was discussing the script with my mother (Poornima Bhagyaraj) at our home. He was telling her about how he was searching for a boy in a particular age group to play an important role in the film. I was in Class Four then and had just come home from school. I walked into their room and was just hopping around, holding my school bag. *Appa* saw me then, and he was like, 'Sonu, un age la oru character irukku.

Pannariya?'. I said 'okay' and just walked out. He was surprised when I agreed immediately, but was also worried that I might feel let down or conscious if I didn't get to act in the film. My mom told him that they could shoot

with me after school and on weekends. But my dad wanted to first do a screen test to see how comfortable I was in front of the camera. So, on that big day, he gave me a dialogue sheet and told me that I should walk inside the room, mouth the dialogues and simultaneously do some actions. So I confidently walked inside the room, took

off my school bag, played around with the phone, all the while delivering my lines. And then suddenly, I stopped and told them that I had to urgently use the restroom, much to their amusement. They all burst out laughing, but I guess my dad was convinced by then that I was at ease in front of the camera. He was like, 'Dialoguesum, action-um simultaneous-a pannaradhu chinna pasangalukku kashtam. Ivan manage panniduvan'. That screen test was the first-ever time I faced the camera and was quite a memorable experience. When Sakkarakatti happened years

later, I was already prepared to face the camera. So, there was no nervousness. The first scene they shot for the film was the one in which Deepali (played by Ishita Sharma) and I break up, but the makers wanted to do a happy shot before that. So, I filmed for a small montage shot — for which I had to smile — on the terrace for the *Marudaani* number.

While I was doing modelling here, my agent suggested that I try acting in a Bollywood movie. I had heard about the creepy side of Bollywood with women facing bad experiences here. I was aware of it and was careful. When I was offered Sonali Cable (2014), I took the plunge. 
You hall from South Africa. How is Arjun helping you to adapt to the culture and life in Mumbai?

We wanted to keep things private. Also, I am very different in that sense. I don't think you necessarily have to get married. I think there is no 'one way' to always do something; to each their own. Yes, there is societal pressure, but personal choices are important. When it comes to deciding what gender you want to be, who you want to date or marry, it should be left to the individual or individuals concerned. Just like in other parts of the world, people here, too, are opening up and accepting others' choices. n the late 90s, after the success of Kaalapani (Siraichalai in Tamil), Mohanlalwhich Priyadarshan combo's most ambitious project then, the late scriptwriter T Damodaran had narrated the idea of a movie on Kunjali Marakkar IV to the director. "It was inconceivable back then to make a film that was extensively set at sea," says Priyadarshan. Now, two decades later, after four months of shooting and over a year of post-production to perfect the visual effects, Marakkar: Arabikadalinte Simham has been censored and is gearing up for release in multiple languages. How different is *Marakkar* compared to other projects you have done to-

We have used our creative freedom and cinematic elements to tell his story on a big canvas, in an entertaining manner. Telling this story has been a big dream for Priyan and me. Scale and artiste wise, after *Kaalapani*, we haven't done such a project.

Priyadarshan: Essentially, it is the story of a patriot. But what makes it different is that almost half the story is set at sea. Creating the old mast ships, war galleys of the Portuguese and the battle sequences in the sea were some of the bigger challenges we faced with the film. I believe that it is the most perfect film using VFX to be made in India. We took 14 months after the shoot to get there. Another aspect that will stand out is that generally, such films herald heroism. Though *Marakkar* has those elements, it is also an emotional film. How much of Marakkar's history is retained in the film?

Priyadarshan: I did some research on him and whatever I could find in history was completely contradictory. In the European version, he was a villain because he waged war against them, but the Arabs hailed him as God. There were four Kunjali Marakkars and it is believed that their bloodline ended with the fourth. So, what I did was take the basic thread of his story from a text I had learnt when I was in Class 3 and give it my spin.

Mohanlal: We have also tried to keep the scenes and characters realistic than take a cosplay approach like in most movies based on Vadakkan Pattukal (Northern ballads of Kerala) and Kappalottiya Thamizhan.

Priyadarshan: Yes, for instance, I had observed that the temperature rose by 3.5 degrees every century and that's why in the 16th century, kings and soldiers used to have their entire bodies covered. The peak summer temperature in Kerala would have been only 21 degrees and this is how it is shown in the movie. Also, it doesn't make sense for soldiers to fight in waters, barechested.

What about Kunjali Marakkar IV appealed the most to you?

Mohanlal: As Priyan said, the basic idea when we started out was to make a patriotic film. If you see, every foreign power that made it to India, first touched base in Kerala — be it the missionaries, traders or explorers. As for Kunjali Marakkar IV, when foreign powers were trying to invade our land, he was at the forefront of resistance and that's probably why he is regarded as the first Naval commander of India. Priyadarshan: Also, contrary to what most people think, Kunjali Marakkar IV died when he was about 53. So,

screen-age wise, I thought it was a perfect character for Mohanlal. It's been over 40 years since both of you entered the film industry. How much has both of

you influenced each other? Priyadarshan: When I went to Bollywood and used to give actors instructions, many of them would tell me that I am acting out exactly like Mohanlal. I learnt from one of the best actors in the country and I am proud of that.

# **SURVEY METHODOLOGY**

he objective of this research was to rank the top schools in each zone in Chennai. The study had two major modules i.e.

MCTM International School, CIT Colony

Factual survey

Perceptual rating survey

In the perceptual survey module, a structured questionnaire was administered with target respondents to arrive at a ranking of schools in Chennai. The sample selection was done using purposive sampling method though the sample was spread out geographically to get better representation. The initial list of schools had over 200 schools of Chennai, though each respondent was asked to give ratings for only those schools that he/she is aware of and known. Each person could rate maximum of 25 schools based on their perception/ experience to ensure that there was neither interviewer nor respondent fatigue and thus ensured better quality data. Teachers were asked to rate the schools (except the school that they were associated with) to avoid any biasedness

#### A sample survey of more than 400 was conducted in (All 5 zones)

- 1. North Zone
- 2. East Zone West Zone
- Central Zone 5. South Zone
- The category of respondents who were intervened rated each of the schools based on their experience with the current school and their perception with respect to other schools. Only Parents of aspiring students (who are currently searching and aspiring to get admissions for their ward) evaluated the schools based on their perception alone. The respondent categories included:

#### Experiential & Perceptual School teachers

- Alumni
- Parents of existing students
- Students
- Perceptual Parents of aspiring students

Extensive Fieldwork was conducted for 4 weeks, starting from 20th Jan 2020

#### MODULE 1 – Desk Research

- A comprehensive list of schools was generated with the help of secondary sources, magazines and other publications. The various sources used for generation of school list included:
- CBSE approved list of schools
- List of school from previous surveys
- Newspapers/ parents', teachers' blogs
- As it is not possible to get a completely exhaustive list of schools and include them in the survey, we had option of adding any new school name in the survey form if any respondent mentioned any school name outside our list. Effectively, every school had a chance of getting covered in the survey if their name was mentioned by the respon-

#### MODULE 2 - Data Collection Factual data collection

More than 200 schools were sent the factual data questionnaire and then were rigorously followed up telephonically to share their factual data.

The factual data sheet focuses on the following information areas:

- General information of the School Establishment
- Affiliation
- Total number of students
- Board toppers Infrastructure & facilities
- Total campus area Laboratories/ other facilities
- Teaching methodology
- Sports facility
- Extra-curricular activity Medical facility
- Teachers facility
- Total number of teachers Student teacher ratio Experience of teachers

- Exchange programs and global exposure
- Disaster Management
- Fee structure

#### Perceptual data collection

A perception questionnaire was administered with respondents. Respondents were asked to give rating for only those schools which they were aware and knew about.

Respondents were provided a list of parameters to evaluate the schools & rate on a scale of 1-10 where 1 meant poor & 10 meant excellent. The list of parameters covered in the survey was arrived at based on past surveys as well as from secondary sources. As mentioned the 5 different stakeholders were taken into consideration for the perceptual survey viz. Teachers, Alumni, Parents of aspiring students, Parents of existing students & Students.

The questionnaire is so designed that both experiential & perceptual target respondents could be exposed to the same set of parameters – this ensured that the scores of different stakeholders could be correlated and collated to arrive at a single final score.

#### MODULE 3 - Analysis of Data & Final Ranking

A robust approach is followed to arrive at the final rankings. The step by step process is given below:

#### Perceptual Score

- Ratings on various parameters for each school
- Calculating importance of various parameters by interacting with key stakeholders the teachers and parents to arrive at weights for each parameter Calculation of raw scores and weighted scores for each
- Calculation of overall score for each school using importance weightages.

#### Factual Score

- Emerging category are the schools that recently started
- and are in existence for a less than 5 years

major modules i.e. Factual survey

Perceptual rating survey

In the perceptual survey module, a structured questionnaire was administered with target respondents to arrive at a ranking of preschools in Chennai. The initial list of schools had over 300 preschools of Chennai, though each respondent was asked to give ratings for only those preschools that he/she is aware of and known.

The category of respondents who were intervened rated each of the preschools based on their experience with the current preschool and their perception with respect to other preschools. Only Parents of aspiring students (who are currently searching and aspiring to get admissions for their ward) evaluated the preschools based on their perception alone. The respondent categories included:

Extensive Fieldwork was conducted for 4 weeks, starting from 20th January 2020

#### **MODULE 1 - Desk**

#### Research

A comprehensive list of preschools was generated with the help of secondary sources, magazines and other publications.

As it is not possible to get a completely exhaustive list of preschools and include them in the survey, we had option of adding any new school name in the survey form if any respondent mentioned any preschool name outside our list. Effectively, every preschool had a chance of getting covered in the survey if their name was mentioned by the respondents.

#### **MODULE 2 - Data** Collection

Factual data collection

More than 300 preschools were sent the factual data questionnaire and then were rigorously followed up telephonically to share their factual data.

- Sports facility
- Extra-curricular activity
- Safety and security related facilities Medical facility

- Fee structure List of 20 Faculty and 20 Students

#### Perceptual data collection

A perception questionnaire was administered with respondents. Respondents were asked to give rating for only those preschools which they were aware and knew about.

Respondents were provided a list of parameters to evaluate the preschools & rate on a scale of 1-10 where 1 meant poor & 10 meant excellent. The list of parameters covered in the survey was arrived at based on past surveys as well as from secondary sources.

The questionnaire is so designed that both experiential & perceptual target respondents could be exposed to the same set of parameters - this ensured that the scores of different stakeholders could be correlated and collated to arrive at a single final score.

#### **MODULE 3 - Analysis of Data & Final Ranking**

A robust approach is followed to arrive at the final rankings. The step by step process is given below:

#### **Perceptual Score**

 Ratings on various parameters for each preschool

 Calculating importance of various parameters by interacting with key stakeholders the teachers and parents to arrive at weights for each parameter Calculation of raw scores and weighted scores for each parameter

 Calculation of overall score for each preschool using importance weightag-

#### **Factual Score**

 The information collected corresponding to similar parameters as in the perceptual survey

 A detailed scoring system has been developed for each parameter

After assigning scores to each param-

eter, raw scores are calculated The raw scores are weighted by their importance to arrive at weighted scores

 The final score for a preschool is a weighted average of Perception Score and Factual Score - equal weight age given to both

 While calculating the ranking – those preschools that did not participate in the factual survey (were assigned average factual score) to make it more holistic. However perceptual scores were obtained for them.

 Best efforts were made to reach maximum preschools and their participation was called for

 The preschools, who have shared their factual questionnaire, were asked to give self-attestation on genuinety and authentication of the information.

 Those preschools which did not share their factual questionnaire within the allotted time, but rank high on the basis of perceptual score were assigned an average Factual score for calculating their overall ranking
